Re: Non-Significant Change Statement

To Whom it may concern;

Cannabis Packaging produced at Intertech Plastics may undergo changes that are not significant in nature and that do not affect the product's Child Resistant feature. In addition, Intertech Plastics regularly reviews production and any proposed changes to ensure that such changes do not affect the Child Resistant feature.

These changes comprise of features or geometries which are not associated with the closure mechanism. These include but are not limited to:

- Base Resin and its Suppliers (While meeting existing specifications)
- Colorants and their Suppliers (While meeting existing specifications)
- Molded-In Markings (Adding / Removing)
- Labeling (In-Mold Labeling)
- Non-Closure related features (i.e. Labeling Lugs, In-Mold Labeling features)

If a significant change is performed to a Cannabis Packaging, a recertification of the Child Resistant feature will be conducted as described in FDA 16 CFR 1700.20.
